Guidelines for Re-opening Church and Worship

OUR RESPONSIBILITIES:

- 1. All entry/exit doors will be opened for you by our Guest Services Team who will be wearing face coverings.
- 2. There will be designated and clearly marked entrance and exit pathways for each Worship Service so that there is one-way flow in and one-way flow out.
- 3. The Worship Center/restrooms/common areas will be cleaned/disinfected between Worship Services.
- 4. Overflow from the Worship Center will be provided in the Student Center at the 9:45 am and 11:00 am services.
- 5. Hand sanitizer stations will be readily available throughout the building.
- 6. No coffee or food will be available.
- 7. Offering boxes will be provided at the entrances and exits of the Worship Center.
- 8. Childcare for ages birth-3 years will be available in Phase 1 and Phase 2 at 9:45 am only. Childcare for ages birth-5 years will be available in Phase 3.
- 9. Limited number of restrooms open.

YOUR RESPONSIBILITIES:

- 1. Time your arrival for 10 minutes prior to the start of the worship service.
- 2. Individuals with serious underlying health conditions, including high blood pressure, chronic lung disease, diabetes, obesity, asthma, and those whose immune systems are compromised (such as chemotherapy or cancer and other conditions requiring such therapy) are encouraged to stay at home and join us online.*
- 3. Those who have a fever and/or feel sick should stay at home and join us online.
- 4. Families and individuals are requested to be mindful of and to practice social distancing while at church.
- 5. Family units may sit next to each other in worship, but everyone is requested to maintain a distance of six feet apart between family units and individuals while seated in worship.
- 6. Masks can be worn and are encouraged.
- 7. Use hand sanitizer and wash hands frequently while at church.
- 8. Sneeze or cough into a tissue or the inside of your elbow.
- 9. No shaking of hands or hugging or any physical contact with others while at church.
- 10. Dress is casual for the summer months.
- 11. We thank the Lord that we can be together. Be kind and respectful to everyone!

In spite of our best efforts, there is an inherent risk associated with the spread of COVID19. While we hope that the efforts between us will diminish that risk, the decision to run that risk rests solely with each individual.
